 - \$250 per partial week day sessions (3 days). Deposit of \$150 (per session) and a \$25 office fee, is required to reserve camp space.
 - Priority will be given to existing lesson students and boarders.

Balance Is due two weeks prior to the selected camp session(s).

Tuition may be refunded, if cancelled two weeks prior, less Office fee, ONLY if an alternate camper can be found to fill the vacated space OR if the session is canceled by White Fences Equestrian Center. A confirmation letter will be e-mailed upon receipt of registration form and payment. **Deposit (less \$25 office fee) is refundable ONLY if an alternate camper can be found to fill the canceled space.**

NOTE: Tuition does not include meals, snacks, or drinks. Camper may bring money for snacks and drinks. Payable in advance with completed registration form, payment must accompany registration, two weeks prior to camp session start date.

Conditions of Nature and Inspection of Premises: I understand that White Fences Equestrian Center is not responsible for total or partial acts, occurrences, or elements of nature that can scare a horse, cause it to fall, or react in some other unsafe way. Some examples are: Thunder, lightning, rain, wind, wild and domestic animals, insects, reptiles, which may walk, run, or fly near, bite or sting a horse or person; and irregular footing on out-of-door groomed or wild land which is subject to constant change in condition according to weather, temperature, and natural and manmade changes in landscape. The parent or legal guardian have inspected the instructional facilities and are satisfied that all premise conditions are reasonably safe for rider's intended purpose, usage and presence upon White Fences Equestrian Center.

Nature of the Horse: Horseback riding is classified as RUGGED ADVENTURE RECREATIONAAL SPORT ACTIVITY, and there are many obvious and non-obvious inherent risks always present in such activity despite all safety precautions. No horse is a completely safe horse. Horses are 5 to 15 times larger, 20-40 times more powerful, and 3-4 times faster than a human. If a rider falls from a horse to the ground, it will generally be at a distance of 3.5 to 5.5 feet, and the impact, may result in injury to the rider. Horseback riding is the only sport where one much smaller, weaker, predatory animal (human) tries to control and become a unit of movement with another much larger, stronger, prey animal (the horse), with survival instincts which may include, but not limited to: stopping short, changing direction or speed at will; shifting its weight from side to side, bucking, rearing, falling biting, kicking or running from whatever it perceives as danger.

The undersigned acknowledges the inherent risks involved in riding and working around horses, which risks including bodily injury from using, riding, or being in close proximity to horses, among other risks, and further, that both horse and rider can be injured in normal use or in competition and schooling. In consideration for the purpose of riding and/or working around horses at White Fences, the undersigned does hereby agree to hold harmless and indemnify White Fences and further release them from any liability or responsibility for accident, damage, injury, or illness to the Rider, the undersigned, or to any family member or spectator accompanying the Rider on the premises of White Fences.
