How Compounding Helps

Compounding allows us to combine **anesthetics, anti-inflammatories, vasodilators, and antimicrobials** in a single topical preparation — at the exact concentrations your condition requires. One application addresses multiple aspects of discomfort simultaneously.

Active Ingredients We Use

Lidocaine 2%

Local anesthetic that rapidly reduces pain, burning, and itching at the site of application.

Diltiazem 2%

Calcium channel blocker that relaxes internal sphincter spasm — the primary driver of fissure pain and delayed healing.

Hydrocortisone 2.5%

Reduces inflammation, swelling, and irritation. Particularly effective for hemorrhoidal flare-ups.

Metronidazole 10%

Antimicrobial with anti-inflammatory properties. Reduces local bacterial burden and promotes tissue healing.

Anesthesia + antimicrobial/anti-inflammatory. Effective for symptomatic hemorrhoids and post-procedural discomfort.
