Cardiac Conditions

Custom-strength cardiac medications — captopril, atenolol, furosemide, and more — at pediatric doses.



GERD & Reflux

Omeprazole, lansoprazole, and ranitidine suspensions and compounded capsules at infant and toddler doses.



Neurological & Seizures

Phenobarbital, clonazepam, and other anticonvulsants in custom concentrations and flavored suspensions.



Infections

Custom-strength antibiotics — amoxicillin, azithromycin, and others — when commercial doses don't fit.



Thyroid & Hormonal

Methimazole, levothyroxine, and other hormonal preparations at precise pediatric doses.



Pain & Palliative Care

Custom analgesics, anti-nausea medications, and comfort preparations for children with complex needs.

Flavored Suspensions

Liquids in child-friendly flavors — strawberry, bubblegum, grape, and more.



Capsules & Mini-Caps

Smaller capsules or sprinkle caps that can be opened and mixed with food.



Topical & Transdermal

Creams and gels applied to skin — ideal for children who resist oral dosing.
