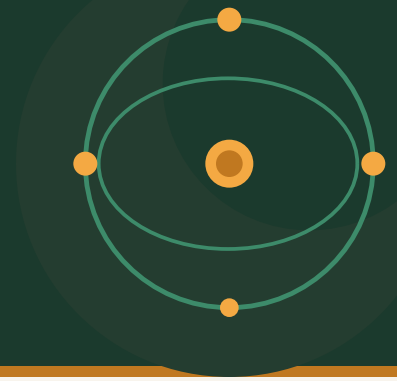


# Enclomiphene

Fatigue, weight gain, low drive, brain fog, and loss of muscle are all common signs. **Enclomiphene** is a prescription oral capsule that prompts your brain to boost your body's own testosterone production — a smarter alternative to traditional testosterone therapy.

## How It Works

Enclomiphene is a **selective estrogen receptor modulator (SERM)**. It blocks estrogen's feedback signal to the brain, prompting your pituitary gland to release more LH and FSH — the hormones that tell your testes to produce testosterone. **Your body makes more of its own T**, rather than receiving it from an outside source.

Feature	Enclomiphene	Traditional TRT
Raises testosterone	✓ Yes	✓ Yes
Uses your body's own T	✓ Yes	✗ Replaces it externally
Oral — no injections	✓ Daily capsule	✗ Usually injected
Preserves fertility	✓ Yes	✗ Often suppresses
Avoids testicular atrophy	✓ Yes	✗ Common side effect
