Situation Overview

The **Carr Fire** broke out in Shasta County during exceptionally dangerous fire weather conditions, including extremely hot temperatures, low humidity and erratic winds. These conditions have caused the Carr Fire to grow uncontrollably, causing widespread destruction and at least two fatalities.

On July 27, 2018, Governor Edmund G. Brown Jr. requested Direct Federal Assistance, including Department of Defense air assets to immediately mitigate the impacts of this fire; shelter supplies and water for 30,000 evacuated residents in Shasta County; U.S. Department of Agriculture's assistance in evacuating large animals; mass care; evacuation assistance for individuals with access and functional needs; and ambulatory transport."

The Governor's Office of Emergency Services has also activated the State Operations Center in Mather, California to its highest level and is coordinating with other local, state and federal emergency response officials to address emergency management needs. [source](#)

As of July 30, 2018, the Carr Fire has burned 98,724 acres, is 20% contained, and is now affecting Trinity County. It has burned more than 723 residences and has forced over 30,000 people to evacuate. [source](#)

The **Mendocino Complex Fire** began on July 27, 2018 in Mendocino County and has burned 35,076 acres and is 5% contained as of July 30. The Ranch Fire and the River Fire are both part of the Mendocino Complex Fire, which is not affecting Mendocino and Lake counties. - **Jul 27 6:28 pm Power Status:** [Redding Electric Utility](#) - REU will be implementing rotating power outages on an hourly basis for residents who currently have power. For those not in the path of or already affect by the fire, power will be restored after an hour. If customers have lost power due to fire, there is no time estimation on restoration. Please make sure that you, family members, and pets are in a safe area where you can still be notified of emergency announcements. An emergency hotline number has been set up, but please reserve it for emergency situations. That number is 245-7000.
