What is phenobarbital used to treat?

Phenobarbital is a generic drug for Luminal Sodium®. It is a barbiturate used to treat seizures and as a sedative drug in cats and dogs.

What are the side effects of phenobarbital on cats or dogs?

The most common side effects include sedation when therapy is started, increased thirst, urination, and appetite, and lethargy.

If you suspect any side effects, overdose, or an adverse reaction to phenobarbital, call your vet office immediately or <u>A.S.P.C.A.'s Animal Poison Control Center</u> at 888.426.4435. A change in dose or medication may be warranted based on the determination of the veterinarian.

How do I know if I need phenobarbital to treat my cat or dog?

Some signs of seizures that can be displayed in your pet include the following: muscle twitching, loss of consciousness, drooling, chomping, tongue chewing, or foaming at the mouth
