What is gabapentin used to treat?

Gabapentin is a generic drug for Neurontin®. It is an anti-seizure and pain medication that is used with other medications to treat seizures and is also used to treat chronic pain, primarily nerve pain in both cats and dogs. It is also used to help with pain associated with surgery.

What are the side effects of gabapentin on cats or dogs?

The most common side effects include sleepiness, incoordination, occasional diarrhea, vomiting, and depression.

If you suspect any side effects, overdose, or an adverse reaction to gabapentin, call your vet office immediately or <u>A.S.P.C.A.'s Animal Poison Control Center</u> at 888.426.4435. A change in dose or medication may be warranted based on the determination of the veterinarian.

How do I know if I need gabapentin to treat my cat or dog?

Some signs of seizures that can be displayed in your pet include the following: become unsteady and have trouble walking or balancing, fall to the side, and lose consciousness.
