FAPSC Foundation Scholarship

Recognizing the importance of career education, the **FAPSC Foundation Scholarship** was created to provide assistance to qualifying students interested in pursuing education through FAPSC member schools. The scholarship provides tuition assistance to individuals with a desire to complete career education and is based on applicant excellence.

Who May Apply

Anyone who meets the admissions and eligibility requirements of the selected FAPSC member school.

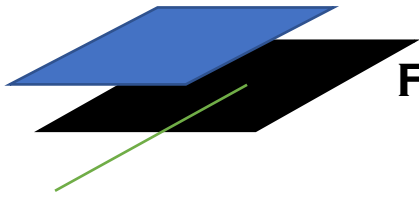
How to Apply

Follow the steps below:

1. Complete the application, identifying the FAPSC member school chosen. Only one school may be identified and applications that do not identify a school will not be processed.
2. Provide a personal statement in the form of an essay no more than 500 words in length. The essay must include the following criteria:
 - a. The applicants career goals and aspirations and how education will help them achieve these goals. A brief overview of the applicant’s current career status, personally and professionally. A statement expressing why they should be considered for this scholarship and why they chose this FAPSC member school.
3. Attach three letters of recommendation as references:
 - a. These references must be from employers, work associates, current or former instructors, or other parties qualified to speak to the applicant’s character, commitment and desire to pursue their education.
4. Sign and date the completed application.
5. Return the completed application form and supporting documents in one package to the FAPSC Foundation before the deadline shown for applications to lindaw@FAPSCFoundation.org with a copy to lweldon@earthlink.net.

Deadline

The application packet, including the completed application, essay, and three recommendations, must be submitted to the FAPSC Foundation by the deadline listed. Incomplete submissions will not be considered.



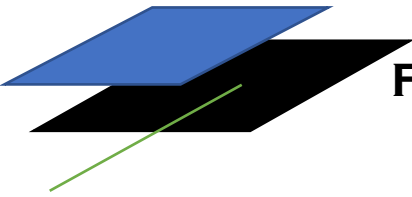
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Award Recipient Selection Process

The Foundation Board (or designees) shall review the applications using a rubric provided to make sure all applications are given equal consideration. The decisions of the Foundation Board are final and may not be appealed.

Scholarship Recipient will be notified, in writing, prior to the designated class start date. Disbursement of scholarship funds are to be made directly to the chosen school and in accordance with the written agreement between the Foundation and the school. Scholarship funds are for tuition only. Under no circumstances shall the grant of a scholarship result in a cash award to a student or be disbursed as a credit balance.

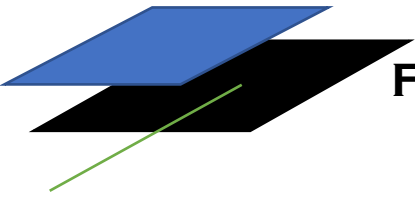

These funds will be applied to tuition before any other funding. The scholarship disbursement will be made to the school after the refund period has ended for the term I begin my enrollment.

I must enroll and start at the school I have chosen within 90 day of the award being made, or the next available school start date, whichever is later.
