Acknowledgement of Funds

Summit Salon Academy – Tampa has signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education the Certification and Agreement to receive the Student and Institutional Portion of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund. The institution further acknowledges that it will use no less than fifty percent of the funds received under section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to its students.

Instructions to Students

At Summit Salon Academy – Tampa, \$224,446 has been allocated to the academy. \$112,223 of the previously mentioned amount has been allocated to assist students through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund. The academy will have an application process to facilitate the distribution of funds. Applications will be considered and approved based on documented need and expenses due to COVID-19. Students who are approved will receive a grant equal to \$1,000.

Application

Students seeking consideration for assistance from the HEERF are advised to complete the HEERF application found on our website. Students who apply must attest, under penalty of the law, that the expenses detailed in the application are true and accurate and be able to produce documentation of expenses incurred. The application will be available from May 18, 2020 to Sept 30, 2020. Notification of awards will be sent 7-14 business days after the approval of a submitted application and funds will be delivered through a paper check to the student no later than 14 business days from the date their application is approved.
