### **Pentas**

An excellent pollinator. It blooms all summer long. The large clusters of starry blooms are the perfect resting place for butterflies, hummingbirds, and bees. Grows well in the ground and in containers.

### **Wave Petunia**

Add an eye-catching pop of color with the Wave Petunia. You cannot go wrong no matter where you plant it: garden, hanging basket, or planter. Full sun with moist, well-drained soil.

### **New Guinea Impatiens**

New Guinea Impatiens provide hard-to-find colors in shade and part sun. This plant adds flair to any space with its bold, lustrous foliage and showy blooms.

### **Gazania Daisy**

This cheery flower is perfect for the sunny garden or in a container. Perfect for the gardener without a lot of free time as this plant needs little care. Tolerant of heat and poor, dry soil.

### Vinca Vine

This leafy vine is the ideal addition to any planter or hanging basket. Blue flowers appear in early spring. With moist soil, it can be grown in sun or shade.



### **Creeping Jenny**

Ground cover plant with limegreen tones. Forms a golden carpet throughout summer and fall. Can also be used as an accent trailing plant in hanging baskets or containers. Tolerant of both low and high light conditions.



### **Dahlia**

Sturdy plants with gorgeous starburst blooms. Be sure to keep weed-free and well-watered. Dahlias need to be planted in well-drained soil and full sun.

### Lantana

Lantana have long been admired for their extended bloom time and ombre coloration. This favorite of butterflies does best in sunny areas with well-drained soil.

### Pink Mandevilla

Requires a minimum of 4-6 hours of direct sunlight a day for continued flowering. Allow soil to dry slightly between watering. Can be brought inside for winter and returned outside in spring after the last frost.



### Bacopa

Bacopa is an excellent white blooming trailer in hanging baskets or as a ground cover. This plant flowers nonstop through the entire growing season.



### **Coleus**

Stunning colors of foliage with combinations of green, yellow, pink, red, and maroon. Partial shade, well-drained soil.



### **Gerbera Daisy**

Originating in South Africa, these bright and cheerful plants are a favorite for many. Plant in full sun and water the base of the plant in the morning to keep plants happy and fungus-free.

### **Red Canna**

Tropical-like foliage and large flowers that resemble irises. Low maintenance and easy to grow. Offers long-lasting color in the garden. In cooler areas, can be replanted in spring by letting the plant die back, then stored. 3-5 feet in height at maturity.



### Calibrachoa

Like a tiny petunia on steroids, Calibrachoa (aka Million Bells) grows and flowers at an amazing rate. These extremely vigorous plants make for colorful, cascading accents in containers or hanging baskets, along, walkways, and on garden walls.

### Marigold

These bright blooms are commonly gifted for Mother's Day or grown for school projects. Enjoy full sun and dry or moist soil.



### Alyssum

Few annual plants meet the hardiness and drought tolerance of sweet Alyssum. With lightly scented flowers, it is a great addition to rock beds, borders, and dry zones. Full sun to part shade.

### Zinnia

Zinnias are the toughest annual you can plant. These sun-loving plants make excellent cut flowers. Assorted colors\*



### Snapdragon

Provide a range of cool season color. Best in full sun with welldrained soil, these plants can handle early spring frost. Plant early for most abundant bloom and performance.

### Coleus

Stunning colors of foliage with combinations of green, yellow, pink, red, and maroon. Partial shade, well-drained soil.



### Petunia

This hardy plant is a summertime favorite. Enjoys full sun and welldrained soil. For best outcomes, keep soil moist but never soggy. Pinch off dead flower heads to encourage new blooms.

### **Spider Plant**

Spider plants are very adaptable. They thrive in indirect light and prefer moist soil. Spider plants are an excellent air purifier.



### Swedish Ivy

A great plant prized for its trailing growth habit. Swedish Ivy prefers indirect light as well as moist soil.



### **Boston Fern**

Ferns thrive in moist, shady outdoor areas, but the lush green foliage will also grow well in indoor/outdoor hanging pots. Requires indirect light, likes high humidity, and needs good drainage. Keep soil evenly moist.



### Silver Inchplant

Requires 4-6 hours of indirect



sunlight daily. Allow soil to dry slightly between waterings. Full sun will cause leaf burn.



### **Petunia**

This hardy plant is a summertime favorite. Enjoys full sun and welldrained soil. For best results, keep soil moist but never soggy. Pinch off dead flowers to encourage new blooms.

### **Bonfire Begonia**

With its bright red blooms, this plant will flower all summer long. Hang this basket in full sun to part sun to help keep leaves dry and free of excess moisture.



### **Torenia**

Also known as the "clown flower" for its cheery and quirky look. Needs to be in part shade and kept wellwatered. Torenias are a favorite of hummingbirds.
