

Coleus

Red Canna

Pink Mandevilla

Requires a minimum of 4-6 hours of direct sunlight a day for continued flowering. Allow soil to dry slightly between watering. Can be brought inside for winter and returned outside in spring after last frost



Elephant Ears

Tropical plant that grows from tubers or bulbs that grow in partial shade to full shade. Keep soil moist. Before first frost move inside or dig up and store. 18-36 inches in height.
