

John Lucas All-Star Weekend Tournament Rules

The John Lucas All-Star Weekend Tournament is a grade-based tournament.

Tournament Rules:

- The National High-School Federation Rules and Regulations will apply to all tournament games.
- Intermediate size ball (28.5") will be used for 3rd – 6th grade divisions. Regulation size ball (29.5") will be used for 7th - 12th- grade divisions
- All Divisions will play 14 to 16 min. Stopped Halves. 3rd - 6th Grade: 14-minute Halves; 7th- 12th Grade: 16-minute Halves.
- Timeouts (1) 30 sec & (1) 60 sec per half, NO carry over. (1) 30 secs in OT, NO carry over.
- Fouls - 6 per player / 10 team fouls is 1 & 1 / 13 team fouls is double bonus, 2 shot
- Warm-up: 3 minutes / Halftime: 3 minutes / Overtime: 2 minutes / Double Overtime: Sudden Death
- 20 Point Lead – 20 points or more clock runs until lead is 15 or less.
- All Technical fouls refer to The National High-School Federation Rules and Regulations.
- Any Coach or Player receives a 2nd technical foul will automatically result in an ejection from the game and facility for the remainder of that game.
- All Forfeits are a 20-0 win.
- **All teams are expected to arrive for games thirty (30) minutes prior to the scheduled start times.**
- Game time is forfeit time. Site Director has final say in certain situations.

Coaches/Team Responsibilities:

- Each team is allowed 2 coaches in the event.
- All Coaches are required to always wear both coach's wristband and badge to enter facility and sit on the bench.
- Coaches that are not in compliance with this rule will be removed from the bench by the John Lucas Enterprises Staff or officials.
- (There will be a \$50 fee to replace a coach's credential.)
- Only Coaches and team players are allowed to sit on their designated team bench.
- NO Spectators are allowed to stand or sit behind the team benches or clock table.
- John Lucas Enterprises will supply the game ball.
- Each team must bring their own warm-up balls.
- **Home Team** is listed on the left of the game schedule, sits on the **left bench** facing the game clock, and wears **light color uniform**.
- **Visitor team** sits on the **right bench** facing the game clock and wears **dark color uniform**.
- Bracket play Home Team is listed on top.
- Scorebooks must be filled out with Players full name and jersey number before the official game time.
- (Note: full team roster must be entered in the Scorebooks for the tournament.)
- A team can only have 12 players per a team.
- Players will be allowed to play for one team only.
- Once a player plays in a game for one team, he will no longer be eligible to participate for any other team in the tournament

Center Court Clock Table:

- The clock keeper and book keeper only at this table.
- NO Spectators are allowed at this table.
- Clock and book keeper will be supplied by John Lucas Enterprises.
- No additional books or personnel at this table.
- There is no checking of book by non- participants during the game.

Game Ball Size

- Intermediate size ball (28.5") will be used for 1st – 6th grade divisions.
- Regulation size ball (29.5") will be used for 7th – High School divisions.

Official Game Ball and Warm-Up Balls

- John Lucas Enterprises will supply the official game ball.
- Each team must bring their own warm-up balls.

Tie Breaker:

- If 2 teams are tied, head to head between the 2 teams determines winner.
- If the 2 teams did not go head to head, then point differential will be used with 15 points being the maximum allowed.
- More than 2 teams tied, teams are then ranked according to the sum of the point differential, highest number placing first, the second highest placing second and so on.
- Defensive Point System- If 2-3 teams are still remained tied after the above tie-breakers, the team with the lowest total points allowed will advance. The remaining teams will revert back to & start at tie-breaker.

Protest Fee and Rule:

- Protest fee will be \$400 CASH. No credit cards accepted.
- Must be paid before the ball tips off for the next game.
- If a protest is lost the entire \$400 is non-refundable.

Attention: NO TOLERANCE POLICY

- Coaches, players, parents and those attending event must be good sports and have proper conduct. Swearing & bad language will not be tolerated. Site Directors have the option to remove anyone from the tournament.
- Any type of physical fighting by Coaches, Players and Spectators could result in IMMEDIATE and FINAL ejection of the team from the tournament with no refund.
