Required Team Paperwork:

This tournament will use National Sports ID to verify each team's documentation. ***All required documentation must be submitted by March 27, 2026.*** Please have the parents of each player click on the link below and follow the prompts to create an account, add their child and complete the 3-step process to get him verified. If you have any questions, please use the LIVE CHAT on the National Sports ID website for assistance.

They will need the following items for verification:

1. Headshot photo of their child
2. Birth Certificate, Passport OR State Issued ID
3. Report Card, Progress Report or some school document that shows the child's current grade for the 2023-2024 school year.

Final Rosters:

All final rosters must be submitted by ***March 27, 2026 (NO EXCEPTIONS)*** on the National Sports ID website.

Hotel Requirements:

We have a Stay-and-Play policy for this tournament. All non-commuting teams participating in the tournament must make all hotel accommodations using our hotels listed below. Please book your hotel accommodations as soon as possible. Travel Arrangement:

There are two airports in the Houston Area. Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH) is approximately 13 miles and Houston Hobby (HOU) is approximately 20 miles from the gym facilities and hotels. Please allow extra time for travel from airport to facilities due to heavy traffic. The last championship game will approximately start at 6:30pm on Sunday, April 12th. Each award ceremony will follow each division championship game (please allow extra travel time). ** Southwest Airlines only flies out of Houston Hobby (HOU).

Mandatory Team Check-In:

There will be a mandatory team check-in on April 10, 2026 (location and time TBA). All teams will be given two (2) Coach Credentials at check-in. Additional Coach Credentials can be purchased for \$40. Coaches must wear their credentials at all times. The credentials allow coaches admission into facilities and permits them to sit on the bench during games. If you misplace or lose your credentials, you will have to purchase a replacement at \$40.

Coach's Information:

Please note the following rules:

- There is a mandatory dress code for all coaches. Each coach is required to wear a polo shirt and khaki or denim pants.
- Each team is required to bring their own practice balls. Game balls will be supplied by John Lucas Enterprises.
- Clock and score keepers will be provided by John Lucas Enterprises. The only people allowed at the score table are coaches and referees.

Tournament Schedule:

When released, please review your game schedule carefully and pay close attention to game location and time. We will be using several different gyms and it is possible that your games will be at different gyms. Also, we do not accommodate schedule request. Please note that the last championship game(s) will be played on Sunday, April 12th at

approximately 4:30pm. Please be at your designated gym 30-minutes before your game time. If your team is not on the court at game time, your team will have to forfeit that game. As a reminder, forfeit time or no shows a game may disqualify their entire team or organization from participation in this tournament next year.

Player Admission:

All players must wear their uniforms and have their player's pass for admission into the facilities.

General Admission Fee:

There will be a daily admission fee of \$25 for adults and children over 6 years old. All children under 6 years old are free. Armband must be worn at ALL times in order to enter gym facilities (no exceptions). John Lucas Enterprises has a NO Tolerance Rule. Poor sportsmanship and/or verbal abuse of officials or opposing teams by coaches, players, or spectators will not be tolerated. Breaking this rule can cause a team and their spectators to be removed from the facilities. This rule will be enforced.
