



WHAT TO BRING

\$25.00 Key Deposit (Cash or Check ONLY)

- Copy of INSURANCE CARD (Front & Back)**
- Soccer shoes - cleated and indoor (or running shoes)
- Shinguards
- At least ten (10) pairs of socks
- Eight (8) pairs of shorts
- Eight (8) shirts (dark/light colors)
- Sheets for Dorm sized single bed (*not needed for the camps at CofC as campers stay in a hotel)
- Pillow & blanket
- Towels
- Personal toiletries
- Goalkeepers SHOULD bring goalkeeper gloves and multiple jerseys
- *Univ. of West Georgia ONLY - Change for washers and dryers (\$1.25 to wash and \$0.75 to dry)

Be sure that all shoes are well broken-in; new shoes are not recommended.

Do not bring valuables, jewelry or anything not clearly marked with your name.

NOTE: Do not bring any electronic devices. Cell phones are acceptable.

POLICIES AND IMPORTANT INFORMATION

MEDICAL INFORMATION

Be certain to thoroughly read and complete the Medical Release on the back of the application page.

ENROLLMENT

To enroll, complete and return the application form along with the consent for treatment form and a deposit of \$250. The balance is due by the first day of camp. If you are sending an application after June 1st, the total fee must be sent. There is a \$25 late registration fee after June 1st. If paying by credit card, the entire fee will be charged, whether you register on-line or mail in your application. In addition, when you register using your credit card, you will incur a processing fee, as we use the secure PayPal site for the transaction. Due to NCAA regulations there are no discounts. If a player is unable to attend camp, the player will be charged a \$100 service fee and the balance will be applied to next year's camp. If the camp is closed, we will immediately send back your application and check. **All camp information is contained on [this website](#).**

CANCELLATION POLICY

If a player is unable to attend camp, the player will be charged a \$100 service fee and the balance will be applied to next year's camp. There will be no exceptions to this policy.

ROOMMATE POLICY

We can honor roommate requests before May 1st. We normally assign two campers per room.

CONFIRMATION

Mail-in applications will be responded to via e-mail (please include e-mail address on application). On-line applications will receive immediate confirmation.

TRANSPORTATION AND SHUTTLE

Two-way shuttle is provided from airport or bus station and can be purchased from RLSA for \$50.00. Please designate pick-up on application. Include photocopy copy of airline/busline itinerary.

KEY DEPOSIT

All campers are required to pay a \$25 key deposit (CASH or CHECK ONLY) at the Darlington School and Wofford College, which is returned at check-out on the final day of camp upon return of the key.

REGISTRATION DATES

Darlington School/Wofford College - registration begins at 11:00AM and ends at 2:00PM on the first day of camp. Camp Meeting is at 2:00 PM on the first day of camp and is the beginning of camp. Closing ceremonies will begin at 1:00 PM on last day of camp.

College of Charleston Day Camp - registration begins at 7:30 PM at the College of Charleston Soccer Complex (Patriots Point Blvd, Mt. Pleasant, SC) on the first day of camp. Camp Meeting begins immediately following registration on the first day of camp and is the beginning of camp. Closing ceremonies will begin at 12:00PM on last day of camp.

College of Charleston Residential Camps - registration begins at 3:00PM at Quality Suites (Patriots Point Blvd, Mt. Pleasant, SC) on the first day of camp. Camp Meeting begins immediately following registration on the first day of camp and is the beginning of camp. Closing ceremonies will begin at 11:00AM on last day of camp.
