Truckers Against Trafficking

You are invited to participate in a special briefing hosted by Truckers Against Trafficking, Apache Corporation, Noble Energy and the Office of the Texas Attorney General about child sexual exploitation and human trafficking and related local law enforcement efforts on November 14, 2018.

In this briefing, you will learn about the realities of domestic sex trafficking (or forced prostitution) and the critical role trucking and oil and gas workers can play in combating this crime. Because these crimes often occur in places where your employees might frequent (truck stops, gas stations, rest areas, busy city streets, bars, loading docks, hotels/motels and other locations where law enforcement may not always be present), they have the unique opportunity to report these crimes.
