### **Texas Update**

The Texas Legislature is picking up steam on this 11th day of the 86th Session. The Texas House will convene at 11 A.M. and the Texas Senate will convene at 2:00 P.M. on Tuesday, January 22.

Senate Committees have been announced and they may be found <u>here</u>. All indications point to Senate Finance beginning their work on Tuesday morning.

We continue to expect House Committees to be announced at the end of January at the earliest.

#### **New Mexico Update**

The New Mexico Legislative session got underway Tuesday at noon, with Gov. Lujan Grisham delivering her first "State of the State" address. In her address she outlined her agenda for this session focusing on investing in public education, health care and public safety. The Governor also announced NM will join the U.S. Climate Alliance, also increasing the State's renewable portfolio standard to 50% by 2030 and 80% ten years after that.
