- Railroad Commission of Texas Safety Orientation for Field Inspectors At the request of RRC staff, HSE Committee and Regulatory Practices Committee members collaborated to organize safety orientations for RRC field inspectors in each of the three Permian districts (Midland, Abilene, San Angelo). The purpose was to present basic safety expectations shared by PBPA operators, discuss hazards in the field, and strengthen communication between RRC staff and operators. The initiative was a great success. The HSE Committee thanks Dean Gaines and Mark Henkhaus of Apache for their time and hard work in support of this project. We also thank the South Texas Energy and Economic Roundtable (STEER) and its members for inspiring the initiative with a similar orientation in the Eagle Ford.

HSE performance data from 2015 through 2017 were collected, and results were shared with those PBPA member companies who participated.
