### The Permian Basin

- ☐ As of last week, there were 493 rigs operating in the Permian Basin of West Texas and Southeast New Mexico.
  - 39% of all rigs in North America
  - 46% of all rigs in the United States
  - □ 72% of all rigs in Texas
  - 98% of all rigs in New Mexico
- ☐ Through 2017, just in Texas
  - 30 billion barrels of crude
  - 75 trillion cubic feet of natural gas




### Planned Investment in Energy Sector Corridor
