HEALTH, SAFETY & ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE

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The HSE Committee meets on the second Thursday of every other month. The Committee is a forum for HSE professionals and other stakeholders from PBPA member companies to discuss challenges, share best practices, and collaborate on initiatives to improve safety and environmental performance in the Permian Basin.

The HSE Committee submits the following quarterly report detailing the Committee's activities in the third quarter of 2018 and those planned for the coming quarter:

Committee Meeting: August 9, 2018

- Best Practices Series (2 of 3) –Driving Safety in the Permian Basin
 - Hosted and facilitated by Chevron
 - 22 participants attended in person representing 11 companies

Committee Meeting: September 13, 2018

- Best Practices Series (3 of 3) –Spill Prevention in the Permian Basin
 - Hosted and facilitated by ConocoPhillips
 - 25 participants attended in person representing 14 companies

Current Projects & Initiatives

- HSE Best Practices Sharing Series – In the first quarter of 2018, the HSE Committee conducted its first annual HSE benchmarking study. HSE performance data from 2015 through 2017 were collected, and results were shared with those PBPA member companies who participated. Top performers in key areas (injury prevention, motor vehicle safety, and spill prevention) agreed to share their companies' best practices with the committee in a roundtable format. The HSE Committee thanks Jim Colbert of Encana and Simon Walshe of Hunt for championing the benchmarking study and getting the best practices sharing series off to a fantastic start. Thank you to Chevron and to ConocoPhillips for hosting and leading our August and September meetings.

- 2019 Benchmarking Study – Based on the success of our 2018 HSE Benchmarking Study, the Committee has expressed an interest in initiating a similar study in the first quarter of 2019.

Current Topics of Discussion

- Health & Safety – short services employees, contractor safety, fire resistant clothing, lone worker safety, underground utility damage prevention
- Environmental – EPA NSPS OOOOa, TCEQ stack height requirements, Waters of the US, produced water spill reporting, secondary containment, underground utility damage prevention
