RULES ANNOUNCEMENT

Rule Amendments Adopted to §§3.37 and 3.38

At its open meeting on February 26, 2019, the Railroad Commission of Texas adopted amendments to §§3.37 and 3.38 regarding the time period for notice by publication. The adopted amendments will be published in the Friday, March 15, 2019, issue of the Texas Register, with an effective date of Monday, March 18, 2019. During the drafting phase, these amendments were discussed and dissected by the PBPA Regulatory Practices Committee. Through the work of this committee, PBPA was able to provide [official comment](#) on the amendments as well.

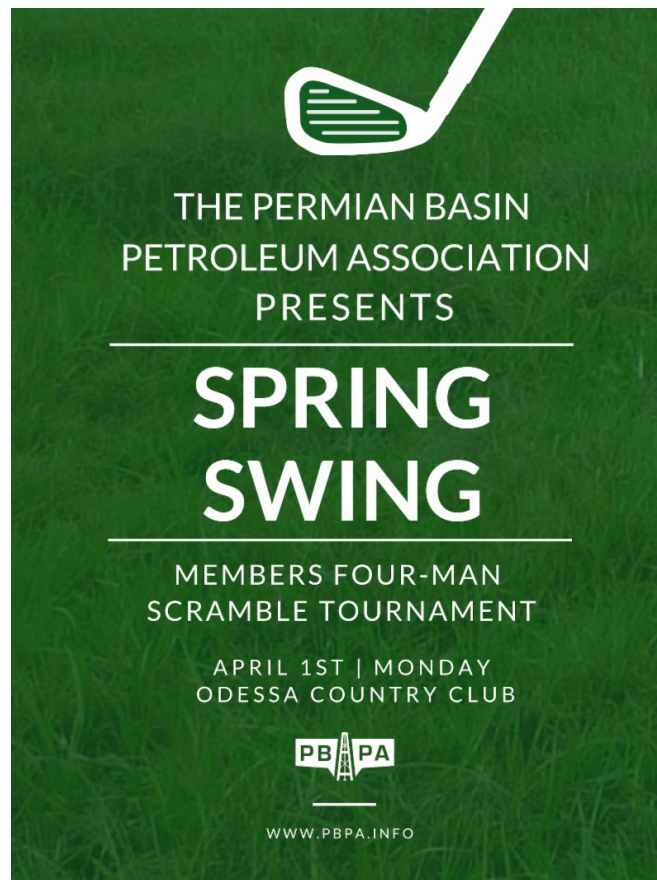


PBPA March Membership Luncheon
