1. PBPA Talks: Next talk series to be delivered by I-20 Wildlife Preserve. Content on playa lakes and their important role in recharging the Ogallala aquifer. Talks to take place in Midland, Andrews and Stanton in November that will focus on oil and gas company stewardship.
