On Tuesday, April 14, 2020, the Texas Railroad Commission met for a Market Demand Hearing, petitioned by Pioneer Natural Resources and Parsley Energy. The hearing began promptly at 9:30 am and enjoyed a litany of testimony from experts in the energy sector including E&P, midstream, and downstream executives along with market analysts, and think tank consultants.

The question at hand was to determine whether or not the Commission should establish a system of pro-rating oil production, as a means to steady supply and stabilize price.

The three Commissioners listened intently for more than 10 hours and asked insightful questions of nearly all presenters taking only minimal breaks for very short periods. Chairman Christian, and Commissioners Craddick and Sitton should no doubt be applauded for their commitment to serve in such difficult circumstances. The agency staff should also be commended for smoothly coordinating a first of its kind type of virtual hearing where all participants were in different physical locations to heed social distancing recommendations.

Over the course of the 10 hour hearing, more than 50 witnesses were called to offer their expertise and the hearing was viewed by nearly 30,000 unique viewers from all over Texas, and around the world. In fact, there were viewers from 49 states and the District of Columbia and 86 countries around the globe on every continent minus Antarctica. In addition to those that testified in person, the Commission received hundreds of written comments from interested parties.

The Commission did not take action on any measures discussed Tuesday.
