Texas Update

The Texas Legislature will convene in 18 days.

As you all know, one of the greatest issues regarding property taxes is how those taxes are inherently intertwined with state spending on public education. On Wednesday, December 19, 2018, the 13 member Texas Public School Finance Commission met to adopt a final report that it has now submitted to the Texas Legislature. Some valuable takeaways from the 48-page report include suggestions for new and greater funding dollars for education, and supports increasing early education programs, while reducing reliance on recapture, or "Robin Hood" style funding methods.

The Texas Railroad Commission has published their year in review, which may be found here. The Commission notes that "During 2018, the Commission conducted hundreds of thousands of inspections, assessed more than \$9.2 million in fines on 3,475 enforcement dockets, continued Information Technology modernization efforts, surpassed key legislative performance measures and increased staff training."

Administratively, the Texas RRC will be closed on Monday, December 24, 2018 and will reopen for regular business on January 2, 2018. New Mexico Update

The New Mexico Legislature will convene in 25 days.

Lea and Eddy Counties have both recommended Lea County business leader Gregg Fulfer to replace retiring Sen. Carroll Leavell. Sen. Leavell retired last month due to health issues. Although the Board of Commissioners in Lea and Eddy counties recommended Fulfer, the decision is ultimately up to Governor Susana Martinez. For more information, click <u>here</u>.
